Subj: UNIFORM POLICY

1. Purpose. This letter provides guidance and policy concerning the uniforms for players, coaches, volunteers, referees, and board members within Cleburne Soccer Association.

2. All recreational player uniforms will be ordered by the Uniform Committee lead by the Uniform Coordinator named by the President of the Association.

3. Player Uniforms will be ordered with the following restrictions:

- 3.1 Only uniforms for youth players that are registered directly through the association may be ordered. Players that register through clubs and/or teams and use CSA as a Home Association are not covered by this policy.
- 3.2 Full uniforms will be ordered for all Recreational youth players in the Fall season or for new players in the Spring season. Returning players from the Fall season to Spring season will use the same uniform.
- 3.3 Uniforms will have limited styles as determined by the Uniform Committee. Style limitations include:
  - a) Jerseys of the same style shall be chosen for U4-U8 players and a different style for U9-U19 players.
  - b) All shorts and socks must be black.
  - c) Special order numbers are not authorized. Coaches may order blank jerseys and have numbers placed on them at their own expense.
  - d) Jersey colors are chosen by coaches on a first come, first serve basis for each age group.
  - e) Sleeveless uniforms are not authorized.
  - f) Names may be placed on uniforms at the team's expense however, all team members should have them.



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- g) All uniforms worn by recreational players must have the Cleburne Soccer Association logo imprinted on the front measuring approximately three (3) inches high.
- h) Any other logos imprinted on jerseys must be approved in writing by the Uniform Committee prior to any matches in which they may be worn.
- i) All recreational players will wear the uniforms produced by the current Uniform Supplier. If additional uniforms are desired (such as home and away jerseys) coaches may purchase these at their own expense from the uniform supplier. Additional uniforms must meet the style guidelines of this policy.

3.4 Uniforms must be ordered six (6) weeks in advance for the main order. Follow-on orders should be ordered as quickly as possible, but standard shipping should be the method chosen for shipping. Faster shipping can be used at the discretion of the Uniform Coordinator in special circumstances.

3.5 Once a uniform has been ordered for a player, that money cannot be refunded if a player no longer wishes to play for any reason.

4. Directors of the Board shall be issued one (1) polo-style shirt each Fall season as chosen by the Uniform Committee.

5. All Cleburne Soccer Association approved volunteers shall be issued one (1) practice t-shirt each Fall season. New volunteers that start in the Spring season may be issued one (1) practice t-shirt.

7. All referees officiating matches for Cleburne Soccer Association shall follow official USSF Uniform Standards. Referees shall be clean and neat in appearance and only wear official referee uniforms when acting in their official capacity as referee. Referees shall be issued one (1) black CSA Referee T-Shirt each Fall season. New referees that start in the Spring season may be issued one (1) CSA Referee T-Shirt.
